

STARTING POINTS FOR SERVICE COORDINATORS FOR CHILDREN WITH VISION LOSS

This list is not meant to be all inclusive. Consider additions appropriate for the particular child and family you are serving. Be sure to obtain parental consent before contacting the ophthalmologist or primary care practitioner and be mindful that some families may choose to share information with you directly.

- Refer family to Perkins School for the Blind website:

- Contact primary care provider about the need to refer the child to an ophthalmologist if that has not been done
- Check to see if eye doctor has referred child to Mass Commission for the Blind
- Inform family about potential benefits, based on family's financial situation

 - SSI
 - WIC
